NEW BUSINESS

Footy Club

Tony advised that the grass on the bank at the rear of the range that members had planted had been poisoned. Paul to investigate.

Tony also advised that the Club is currently negotiating with Paringa Archery Club about the possibility of a partnership in running a medieval fete after next Easter. Hillwood Football Club

Bob McLean referred to a grant from the Liberal Party for \$40,000 to be used on drainage of the ground. Information has been forwarded to the Council and the Club has since made contact with Mr Nic Hansen and has received a quote for the work.

Bob advised that he was hopeful that Council would contribute to the project as part of its maintenance program for the recreation ground. Bob also advised that he had sent correspondence to Anne Cameron in this regard. The State Liberals require approval from George Town Council. It is anticipated that the money will be handed down when the budget is brought down and upon the provision of the required approvals from Council. Bob advised that the work would commence in October and it will take approximately 4 days to complete.

Paul will discuss the application process with Dino De Paoli.

Bob advised that the Club would like to extent the existing Club change rooms and would be putting in a request to Council for the work to be considered in future budgets. Looking at Prime Design possibly drawing up the plans as a sponsorship deal.

Bob advised that as part of the maintenance program each year the Club has to paint the change room floors, because of wear and tear and would like to seek provision of paint from Council to do this in future.

Sand for top dressing is required when the work on the drains is complete.

OTHER BUSINESS

Bob Pooley spoke on the Tasmanian Community Fund program which needs investigation. Members suggested that Anne Cameron be approached in this regard.
