**NEW BUSINESS**

Footy

Ricky Youd reported that there were 1300 movements within the Northern Tasmania Football Association and that there was a lot of work going into a point score system. Each club gets 200 points and are required to stay within those points. Ricky expressed concern that clubs could fold and it all comes down to funds.

Ricky advised that there were OH&S issues with the ground still not draining and this will need to be reinspected and a budget considered for the work. Dino De Paoli advised the Liberals have indicated that council will receive \$450,000 in funding towards the stormwater harvesting project at the sports complex which should assist with the drainage problems.

Ricky discussed consideration of grants to upgrade the light towers and that he had also received a letter from NBN re the lighting on the tower. Dino advised that there would need to be communication with NBN on this.

Ricky advised that the lighting needs to be efficient particular this time of the year for training.

Ricky also advised that the electrical boards have been upgraded as there were issues with the training lights tripping when the kitchen lights were switched on.

Cricket Club

Dean Gibbons reported that all was good however there was a potential lack of players. Dean advised that the club still needs to source an appropriate clock. Bob Pooley has also asked that the grounds be mowed.

Archers Club

Tony McKenzie advised that the power to the Archers Club clubrooms was now connected and secure.

Tony also advised that the line marker had been borrowed from the Football club.

There was a problem with access to the club, particularly during the wetter months. Paul O'Grady advised that was access to the club along the outer perimeter of the bike track next to the stacked trees; there is a section cut away that can be driven on to gain access to the Archery area. Tony will investigate. Tony also advised that the George Town Club was the safest archery site in Tasmania, regulation wise.

Tony advised that the Navy Cadets, the Scouts and schools have indicated they would like to use the Club however there was a safety issue with the schools requiring it for shorter time frames (15 minutes).

Tony advised that he would like a representative from the Council to come to the Club in regard to the requirements for cooking and food preparation. Tony advised that food is not prepared on site but there are facilities there and it can be done. Dino advised that he will arrange for Council's Environmental Health Officer to visit.
