

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

All Local Government Rates are exempt from Goods & Services Tax.

PENSIONER RATES REMISSION

Ratepayers who hold a Pensioner Concession Card, Health Care Card or a Repatriation Health Card (ie 'Gold Card' endorsed Total or Permanent Injury (TPI) or War Widow/Widower DVA) on 1st July 2017 and meet certain State Government criteria may be eligible to apply for a rate remission.

To be eligible you may only claim for one property and it must have been your principal place of residence on 1st July 2018. You also need to have owned the property on 1st July 2018 and have been the responsible ratepayer for this property.

The Pensioner Concession, Health Care or Repatriation Health Card must be presented when making an application.

Application forms are available from the Council Office until the end of March 2019.

HOW RATES ARE CALCULATED

Rates on all properties in the George Town municipality are calculated on a property's Capital Value – that is, rates are levied as a certain number of cents for each dollar of a property's Capital Value and can be varied across the use categories defined in the Local Government Act 1993.

WHAT IS CAPITAL VALUE?

The Capital Value of your property is the total value of the property, including the Land Value but excluding any plant and machinery. The amount is assessed by the Valuer-General and is adjusted every two years.

If you do not agree with the valuation or adjustment factor of your property you may wish to raise the matter with the Office of the Valuer-General. Phone 1300 368 550.

GENERAL RATE

A General Rate of 0.364410 cents in the dollar of the Capital Value is levied on all rateable properties within the municipal area with a minimum charge of \$702.00, however the following categories of properties are rated at:

The General Rate is levied in order to cover the cost of all non-property specific services such as roads, parks, stormwater, tourism and recreation.

AVERAGED AREA RATE (AAR)

Properties that are used or predominantly used for residential purposes within the following localities will be rated by the Averaged Area Rate. Properties will be charged the same amount of rates as per the following table:

WASTE MANAGEMENT & SERVICE CHARGE

Council makes a service charge of \$38.00 for waste management on all rateable land for the establishment, management, provision and rehabilitation by Council of waste management facilities.

The George Town Waste Management Centre is located at Mt George Road. The hours of operation are:

- Non Daylight Savings: 12.00pm to 4.00pm—7 days a week
- Daylight Savings: as above except Wednesday 2pm to 6pm
- Closed: Good Friday & Christmas Day

The Pipers River Transfer Station is located at Parry's Road. The hours of operation are:

- 12.00 noon to 4.00pm— Sunday

There are service charges for waste management in respect of all land to which Council supplies or makes available different waste management services as follows:

- \$178 for a 85 litre garbage bin & a 140 litre recycle bin (Only available to existing users of 85 litre bins)
- \$215 for a 140 litre garbage bin & a 140 litre recycle bin
- \$311 for a 240 litre garbage bin & a 240 litre recycle bin (Only available by written request signed by the property owner)

A weekly wheelie-bin garbage collection is provided in all areas. A recycling service is provided fortnightly. Please refer to the Garbage & Recycling Collection areas of Council's website for details of collection dates in your area

FIRE PROTECTION RATES

The Fire Protection Rate is not a Council rate; it is levied on behalf of the State Government to contribute towards the funding of the Fire Commission. The Fire Protection Rate is determined by the Fire Commission and is based upon a property's Capital Value.

An Urban Fire Rate of 0.0246143 cents in the dollar of the Capital Value or the sum of \$40.00 whichever is the greater is levied on all rateable land within the George Town Volunteer Brigade Rating District.

A Rural Fire Rate of 0.0231599 cents in the dollar of the Capital Value or the sum of \$40.00 whichever is the greater is levied on all rateable land that is not within the George Town Volunteer Brigade Rating District.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Payments can be made weekly, fortnightly, monthly or instalments.
