

21st December 2016 Ordinary Council Meeting Decisions

Listed below is a brief description of the decisions of Council at its meeting held on the 21st December 2016:

- Council resolved to continue to support a combined application for rezoning and a 2 lot subdivision at 14 Brownrigg Street, Hillwood in accordance with S.39 (2) of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993*.
- Council approved the funding of \$20,000 from unallocated reserves to fund Stage One of the Smith Street, Bellingham drainage works.
- Cr Parkes and Cr Glisson were appointed to the George Town Council Audit Panel until October 2018 with Mr Steven Heryk reappointed as Chairperson for a further term of 2 years.
- Council resolved to commit the following funding to be incorporated into the 2017/2018 budget for the following projects, subject to successful applications that provide for 50% for co-funding of the project total estimated costs:
 - George Town Football Club building accessibility upgrades \$25,000
 - George Town Cricket Club building, accessibility upgrades \$25,000
 - York Cove beautification and upgrade works \$125,000
- Community grants were approved for:
 - \$1,500 - Hillwood Fire Brigade Social Club to assist with the cost of lollies purchased for the annual “Christmas Day Lolly Run”.
 - \$200 - Ladies Leisure Centre to cover hall hire fees for the Graham Fairless Centre and Kitchen associated with the 2017 Cancer Council Biggest Morning Tea.
- Council agreed to lease 1 hectare of land at 92-96 Main Road George Town to the Campervan Motorhome Club of Australia (CMCA), subject to a development application from the CMCA being successful.
- Council adopted its Council meeting dates for 2017 (refer Council’s website).
- Council formally adopted its 2015/16 Annual Report and confirmed the Minutes of its 2016 AGM.
- Council agreed to advertise the Draft York Cove Concept Development Plan for public comment over the January/February 2017 period (refer Council’s website).
- Council considered motions from the 2016 AGM and supported the Officer’s Recommendation for each of the five motions (refer December 2016 Agenda).
- Council resolved to request the General Manager to make arrangements for rate modelling to be conducted, to review possible alternatives, for Council’s further consideration.
