

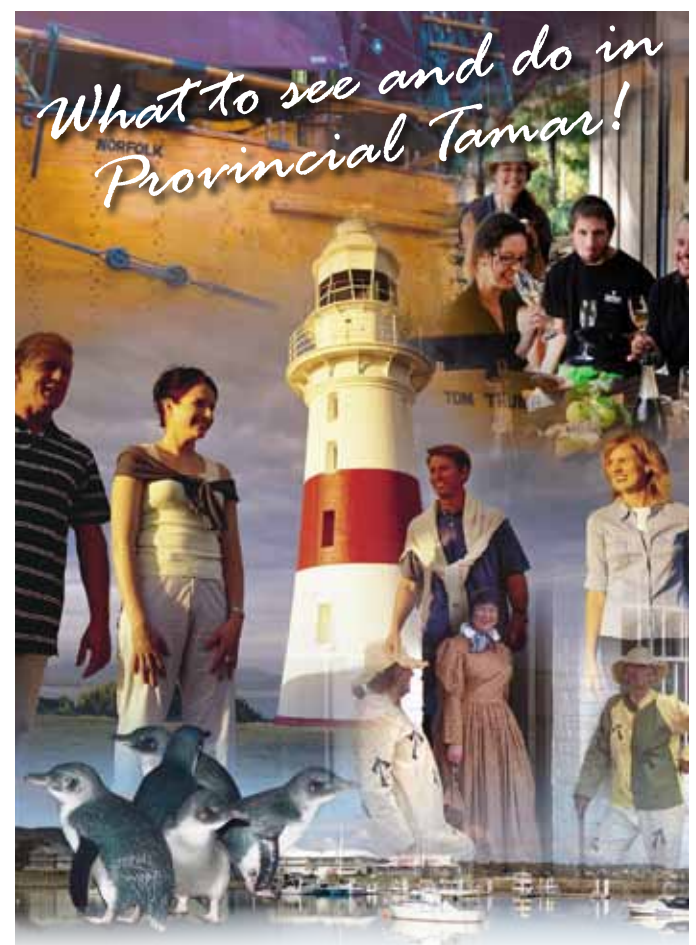


GEORGE TOWN

Trails



Kanamaluka Walking & Cycling Trail

Walk or ride around our scenic trail from George Town to Low Head. Cycling will take you about 2 hours and walking approx. 4 hours. Hire your bike from the Visitor Information Centre!

George Town Heritage Trail

Take a self guided tour of historical sites of George Town and Low Head or purchase an **Historical Attraction Pass** to gain entry into the **Watch House, Bass & Flinders Centre and Pilot Station Maritime Museum**. Available at the Information Centre or venue.

Tamar Valley Wine Route

Highlight of the Tamar Valley Wine Route, Pipers River is about 20 minutes drive from George Town and is home to an array of award winning wineries.

Arts

Mount Direction Signal Station

Located at the top of Mount Direction on the East Tamar is the old Signal Station. Used as a semaphore signal system for communication, the trail winds its way to the north giving uninterrupted views to Mt George.

Paterson Monument

Take a step back in history and visit the point where Colonel Paterson and his crew stepped ashore in 1804.

Bass & Flinders Centre

Discover some of the great maritime stories of Australia and board the huon pine replica of the "Norfolk". Open seven days a week 9.30am-3.30pm



Watch House

Female factory bonnet display and Model Village take you back to the early years of one of Australia's oldest settlements. Open Mon-Fri 10am-3pm Sat-Sun 1pm-3pm

Low Head Pilot Station

Built in 1805 it is the oldest continuous working Pilot Station in Australia and sits at the end of the historically preserved precinct. The pilot service still operates from this site today.

Low Head Maritime Museum

Situated at the Pilot Station and home to excellent displays of historic artefacts, the Museum houses 12 rooms of different maritime interests. Definitely not to be missed! Open seven days a week from 10am-4pm except Xmas Day.



Low Head Lighthouse

Walk up and around the lighthouse and see the superb views of the Tamar River and coast line - perfect for pictures! The Lighthouse was built in 1888 and is still in service although completely automated.

Low Head Fog Horn

Hear the fog horn sound every Sunday at 12 midday. One of the few operating Type "G" diaphones in the world.

Batman Bridge

It's where East Tamar meets West Tamar. The Batman Bridge is the first cable stayed bridge in Australia and was built between 1966 and 1968.

Mount George Lookout

Drive up to the top and stroll along the board walk to see the magnificent views and the remains of historical gardens and living quarters. A must for photographers!

Windmill Point & East Beach Carvings

Old macrocarpa pines have been transformed by artist Eddie Freeman with his chainsaw and chisel. Moments in George Town's iconic maritime history have been magically captured—hauling the submarine cable ashore, whales, penguins, old replica ships and more.

Low Head Penguin Tours

Early dusk is a perfect time to experience an up close and personal encounter with the Low Head Penguin Tours. Listening to your guide and getting familiar with the penguins, this tour is not to be missed! Phone Shirley to book on 0418 361 860.
