

16th September 2015 Ordinary Council Meeting Decisions

Listed below is a brief description of the decisions of Council at its meeting held on the 16th September 2015:

- Council resolved to support a combined application for amendment to a local provision of the George Town Interim Planning Scheme 2013 and a 11 lot subdivision in Hillwood (4 Ridge Street and Craighburn Road) thereby progressing the application through to exhibition with the knowledge that any representations received will be presented to the Planning Authority for further consideration; and with the knowledge that any permit issued, associated with the proposed subdivision will be done so by the Tasmanian Planning Commission subject to the recommended conditions for the draft development permit.
- Council resolved to form a Committee consisting of the whole Council in order to consider submissions in regard to an application by Archer Bushby Lawyers to amend Sealed Plan No. 142734 (removal of Part V Agreement Lot 1 Victoria Street, George Town) and that a date be determined for the hearing that suits all relevant parties and formally invite the petitioners to provide submission either in writing prior to the scheduled date, or verbally at the hearing.
- Council approved a number of community grants to:
 - LINC Tasmania of \$83 to cover hall hire fees applicable for the use of the Memorial Hall for their School Holiday Dance Workshop; and
 - Lighthouse Regional Arts of \$182 to cover the hire fees for the use of the Jim Mooney Gallery for the Association's "50 Shades of Blue" Exhibition; and
 - George Town Hospital Auxiliary of \$140 to cover costs associated with Council's depot staff time for the delivery and return of chairs and marquees for use at the Auxiliary's Open Day on the 24th September 2015; and
 - Launceston Triathlon Club of \$800 to assist with costs to run the 2015 George Town Triathlon on Sunday 6th December 2015.
- Approved an Achievement Grant of \$200 to Leah Renton to assist with costs associated with her selection as a member of the Tasmanian Swimming Team

which will compete at the Pacific School Games in Adelaide during November 2015.

- Approved sponsorship of \$1,000 to the George Town Rotary Club to assist with costs associated with their annual Wings & Things Event
- Received the report on the George Town Council Community Satisfaction Research Report 2015 which will be made publicly available via Council's website and agreed to consider repeating the survey in two years in conjunction with the LGAT State wide Customer Survey subject to budget allocation at that time.
