I would like to advise due to a variety of reasons, CMCA will be withdrawing its Development Application to create a RV Park in the town. Over the past 24 months, we have found it difficult to achieve our milestones to ensure that we can develop this low-cost park in an appropriate time frame and budget.

The delay with Council addressing key planning and costing issues has not helped, in fact we have had to come back to Council staff several times with amendments and changes to accommodate the bureaucratic processes. This has all been at our cost.

I would like to acknowledge the support our member and your resident Don Mackrill, who has tried valiantly to pursue this project in the best interests of the George Town business sector and community and even he at times became frustrated with the process.

CMCA will continue to support George Town as a RV Friendly Town but unfortunately at this time we will look for other options in Tasmania for an RV park development.
