The program will focus on the power of grassroots advocacy, combining workshops, speakers’ panels, and group discussions to provide a rewarding and welcoming environment for young councillors to discuss issues that are important to them.

Participants of this program will work on project proposals and develop submissions which will be presented to elected Councillors at the program’s conclusion with the hope that some of these proposals may be adopted by local governments across the state.

Throughout this process, the participants will develop public speaking, planning and problem-solving skills that will allow them to positively contribute to their schools and communities. These skills are essential in giving them the confidence and necessary skills to become advocates for the issues they believe in. The program will also connect participants with like-minded people to form friendships and collectively contribute to a stronger community, in which young people feel heard by those that represent them.

The Tasmanian Youth Local Government (TYLG) conference allows young people to come together in an educational environment to learn about and discuss local government through brainstorming exercises, skills workshops, mock community consultation, council debate and planning and developing motions. The conference encourages participants to step into the shoes of councillors with the aim of educating young advocates in a role of local government and the social and development issues relevant to local government.

Tasmanian Youth Local Government encourages participants to step into the shoes of the councillor, educating young advocates in local social and development issues especially in the areas of public health, indigenous Tasmanians, CALD communities, the maintenance of infrastructure and grassroots investment. The participants, whom we will refer to as councillors, will engage critically with the key roles of local government as the closest tier of governance to the people, learning about representative government, community consultation, co-design, the vertical separation of powers, and civic participation.

We seek to teach an understanding of advocacy, and the role of local government in protecting the community, improving the quality of life and engaging local groups, using current local government initiatives as inspiration. More specifically, we will look to empower councillors to identify and advocate for indices of public concern, where public value lies, theories of good governance, how to guide public behaviour, understanding both sides of a controversial area, and respect for the diversity of community beliefs and practices in Tasmanian communities.

The Tasmanian Youth Government Association thinks globally and acts locally. We aim to provide a forum for young Tasmanians to express their voice and learn extensively, and as such, engagement is critical. We firmly believe that this program provides a method of engaging young Tasmanians to gain an understanding of local government, in this case, we think that engagement is critical for this growth. Previous programs have provided life-changing experiences for participants, and the Youth Local Government taskforce aims to offer the program at a fee that is accessible for young Tasmanians from a variety of backgrounds. 


