Good Afternoon James,

Thank you for the phone call yesterday regarding the representation for 31 Goulburn Street, George Town. I have discussed the representation with our client and they would like to proceed with the plans as they currently stand and understand that this will need to go to the council meeting.

The reasoning for the location of the proposed bathroom is as follows:

- The bathroom is intended to be made available for use by people experiencing homelessness. In order to ensure security of the building, the access to the bathroom needs to be on the exterior/boundary facing walls of the building to enable passive surveillance as well as easy visibility for formal security patrols.
- The bathroom is located to make use of the plumbing in the location from the existing WC which is proposed to be removed.
- The proposed alterations have been carefully designed to comply with accessibility requirement as well as incorporate the spaces requested by the client. These include maintaining large rooms and new smaller rooms allowing for multiply varying meetings for the community as previously detailed.

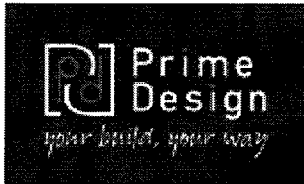
