We currently have a situation where the main doors to the Memorial Hall are being kept locked. There is a defibrillator in the foyer which if not accessed quickly enough could cost a life. I feel that this is a very real safety issue. I also feel that signage should be in place to direct people to defibrillators in the area.

As I volunteer at the hall (but this isn't from Tamar FM but myself) I see constantly elderly people in distress trying to get to the toilets but are unable unless they walk around to the automatic doors to gain access if they know about them. We have events in the area of the hall and visiting bus groups also and this is the only toilet area that can cope. It may pay the Council to talk to Tamar FM who I'm sure could assist with the opening/closing lockdown of this facility. It just makes sense to keep this access to the hall that is so well known to our residents in a time of real need.
